Duration of course : 4 years with 1 year internship

Eligibility : As per Calicut University Norms. Pass in plus 2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. SEBC candidates in the State of Kerala with total annual income upto Rs. 2.5 lakhs are entitled to have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination, to appear for the entrance examination. The SC/ST candidates in the State of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination

Selection Procedure : Eligible candidates are selected through entrance Examination.

Post Basic BSc Nursing Course (2 years)

(Approved by Indian Nursing Council , Govt. of Kerala and Affiliated to University of Calicut)

The College of Nursing started Post Basic B Sc Nursing course in the year 2005 with the main aim to provide opportunity for Diploma qualified Nurses to update their basic education to graduate level.

Duration of course : 2 years. It consists of 4 semesters with University examinations at the end of each semester.

Eligibility : As per Calicut University norms. Pass in +2 or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology as optional subjects. or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to by University of Calicut. Pass in GNM course with minimum 55% marks.

Two years of experience in a 150 bedded hospital after registration from State Nursing Council.

Registered with Kerala Nurses and Midwives council at the time of applying for the course

The upper age limit is 45 years,

For SC/ST, SEBC students minimum marks as per the Calicut University norms.

Selection Procedure : As per the rules of the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNC), Thiruvananthapuram

2. One year experience/internship after BSc Nursing Degree and Registration in State Nursing Council

OR

One year experience prior or after Post Basic BSc Nursing

3. Registration in Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council at the time of applying for the programme.

Selection of the candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by the Govt. / University / competent authority.

General Nursing & Midwifery Course (G.N.M)

((Approved by Indian Nursing Council, Govt. of Kerala & Kerala Nurse's & Midwives Council)

This was a boon as the state was facing acute shortage for good quality INC, KNC approved educational institutions and students were going to other states for nursing education. A good nursing educational institute with required facility at the doorstep was embraced whole heartedly by the community. Presently the school is at Pottore in the WAHE campus.

The organization stands out as one among the best in the country for nursing education as our students are able to complete and stand up to the increasing challenge in the profession. Duration of course : 3 ½ years.

Number of Seats : 55

Eligibility : 10, +2 passed with Physics, Chemistry, Biology as optional subjects with aggregate 45% marks. for SC/ST students, only pass in 10 +2 with Physics Chemistry and Biology.

Age limit : 17-27 Years as on 1st June of the respective year. SC/ST 5 Years & SEBC 3 years relaxation on upper age limit.

Admission Procedure : As per the norms of Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council and INC

Scope : Nursing has wide scope compared to the earlier days where the care was limited to the hospital set up.



WESTFORT INSTITUTE OF PARAMEDICAL SCIENCES, WAHE, THRISSUR

Paramedical Courses:

(All the courses are approved by Government of Kerala and Directorate of Medical Education and Kerala Paramedical Council)

The institute of Paramedical sciences was established in the year 2004. The courses conducted are:

- 1) Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT), 2) Diploma in Radiological Technology (DRT) and, 3) Diploma in operation Theatre Technology (DOTT).

1. Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT)

The objective of the courses is to teach and train students in carrying out modern and advanced Laboratory investigations accurately. Students are also taught the method of giving laboratory reports to Doctors, a vital input in the Medical Care of the patients. Practical training is given in the state of the art laboratories, of our two hospitals.

Duration of course : 18 months followed by 6 months practical training.

Eligibility : Pass with 50% marks in plus Two/Pre degree examination with Physics, Chemistry & Biology of Kerala Universities or its equivalent. For SEBC Students annual income upto 2.5 Lakhs 5% marks relaxation and 10% marks relaxation for SC/ST students.

Selection Procedure : As per the norms of Kerala Para Medical Council/DME

2. Diploma in Radiological Technology (DRT)

The aim of the course is to teach and train students in radiological and imaging techniques, CT Scan etc. including the use of the most advanced imaging machines. The course is to be conducted under the department of Radiology and Imaging of the Hospital.

Duration of course : 2 Years

Eligibility : Pass with 50% marks in plus Two/Pre degree examination with Physics, Chemistry & Biology of Kerala Universities or its equivalent. For SEBC Students annual income upto 2.5 Lakhs 5% marks relaxation and 10% marks relaxation for SC/ST students.

Age Limit : 17 years to 25 years.

Selection Procedure : As per the norms of Kerala Para Medical Council, TVM /DME

3. Diploma in Operation Theater Technology (DOTT)

Aim of this course is to teach and train students in handling variety of electric and electronic equipments used in modern operation theatres and to keep it in good working order and to assist the anesthesiologist.

Essentially the course trains students to assist in the very advanced techniques of Anesthesia.

Duration of course : Two years with Six months compulsory internship.

Eligibility : Pass with 50% marks in plus Two/Pre degree examination with Physics, Chemistry & Biology of Kerala Universities or its equivalent. For SEBC Students annual income upto 2.5 Lakhs 5% marks relaxation and 10% marks relaxation for SC/ST students.

Selection Procedure : As per the norms of Kerala paramedical Council/DME

4. Diploma in Dialysis Technology (DDT)

(Approved by DME, Govt. of Kerala and Kerala Paramedical Council)



The objective of the course is to learn how to help patients with kidney failure by performing dialysis, a procedure in which a machine does the blood purification work of the kidney. In addition to such health care basics as anatomy, physiology, sanitation, and ethics, students learn how to understand dialysis prescriptions, prepare patients, set up equipment, and more.

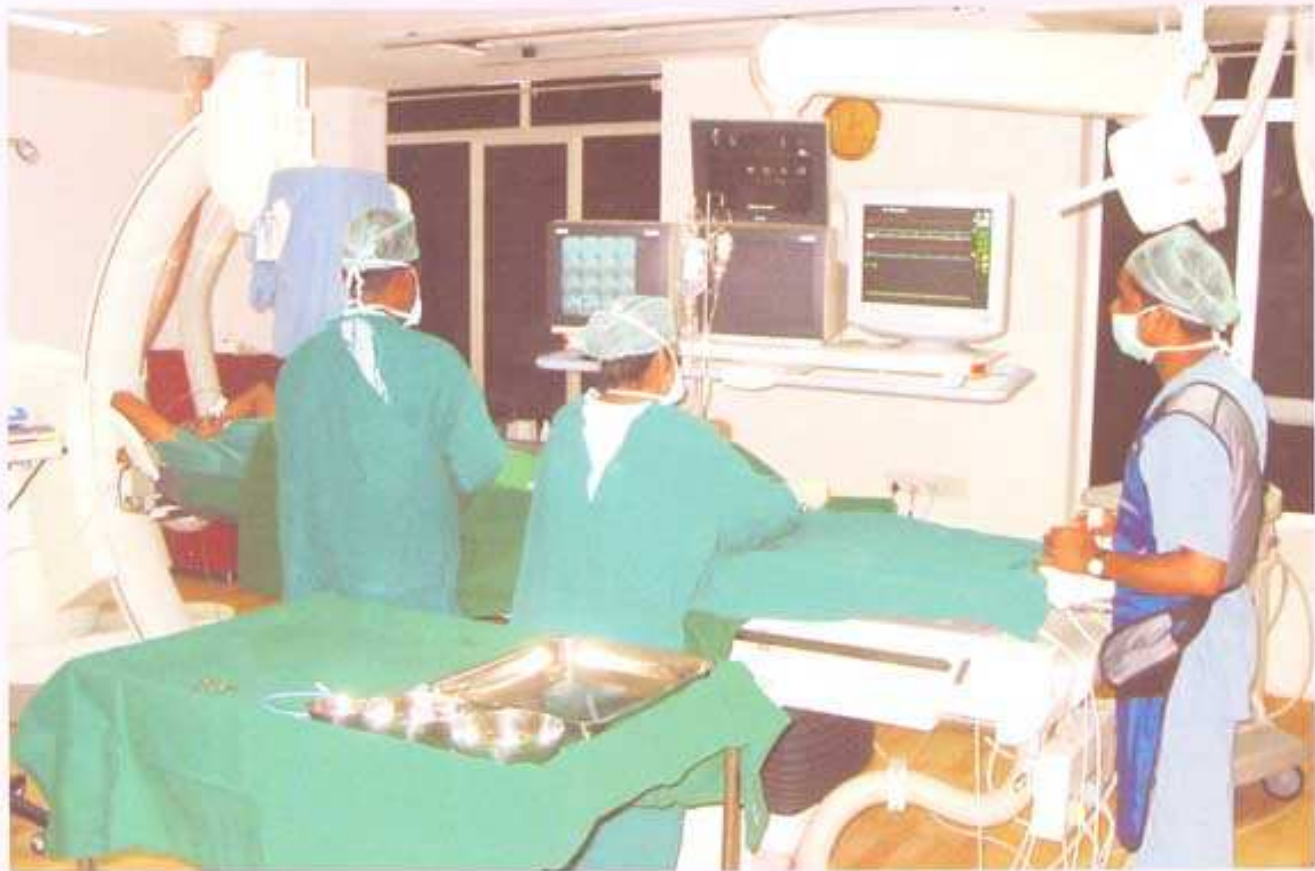
Dialysis technology is a highly specialized field of nephrology. In clinical practice settings dialysis technologists provide dialysis treatment under the supervision of a physician. The dialysis technologist is responsible for all medical devices and equipments involved in renal replacement therapies, such as reprocessing and water treatment equipment. Along with patient care and equipment operation, maintenance, and repair, dialysis technologists act to ensure regulatory compliance.

5. Diploma in Cardiovascular Technology (DCVT)

(Approved by DME ,Govt .of Kerala and Kerala Paramedical Council)



The aim of the course is to assist physicians in diagnosing and treating cardiac (heart) and peripheral vascular (blood vessel) ailments.

Cardiovascular technologists and technicians schedule appointments, perform ultrasound or cardiovascular procedures, review doctors' interpretations and patient files, and monitor patients' heart rates. They also operate and care for testing equipments explain test procedures, and compare findings to a standard to identify problems. Other day-to-day activities vary significantly between specialties.

- Duration of the course** : 2 years.
- Eligibility** : Pass in +2 (plus two) or its equivalent with 50 % aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, Biology .45% for SEBC,40% for SC/ ST candidates
- Age Limit** : 17- 30 years
- Selection Procedure** : As per the norms of DME and Kerala Paramedical Council
